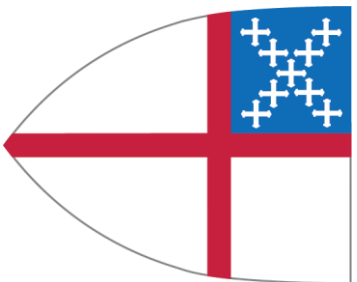

End of Life Resources

End of life resources are offered to all St. Mark's parishioners and loved ones as an opportunity to secure their preferences for funeral and planned giving arrangements before their passing. Many of our parishioners do not make these arrangements and their wishes regarding their funeral service, use of the columbarium, and intentions to leave funds for the church at the time of their passing is unknown.



- Funeral Planning

St. Mark's offers the opportunity to plan your funeral arrangements at any time. Are there particular hymns you would like performed? Is there an individual you would like to read a psalm or give your eulogy? Is there a place other than the sanctuary where you would like the service to be held? This type of planning can eliminate significant decision making for those left behind who are responsible for following your wishes.

- Burial Arrangements

Choosing between cremation, a cemetery burial, or other options can be difficult. St. Mark's can provide spiritual guidance on which option may be right for you and make sure it is documented as part of your funeral plan.

- Columbarium

If cremation is the path you are pursuing, St. Mark's Columbarium is one of the most peaceful and affordable resting places in the area. It is an excellent choice for any of St. Mark's parishioners and we can reserve a space for you and your loved ones.
